The special service district will be authorized to provide the following services: Road Maintenance; Road Improvements; Snow Removal; Storm Drainage; Street Lighting; Sidewalks; Road Signage; Road Striping; Weed Control; and Transportation Studies. Taxes may be levied annually upon all taxable property within the proposed special service district. Fees or charges may be imposed to pay for some or all of the services that the special service district provides. The City Council will hold a public hearing at 7:15 p.m. on October 16, 2013, to give full consideration to each written protest that has been filed and to hear and consider each interested person desiring to be heard. An interested person may protest the creation of the special service district, or a service that the special service district is proposed to provide. Each protest shall be in writing and be delivered to the Santaguin City Council at 275 West Main Street, Santaguin, Utah 84663, no later than 60 days after the public hearing and must explain why the person is protesting. A person who submits a written protest against the creation of the special service district may withdraw the protest or, having withdrawn a protest, cancel the withdrawal, no later than 60 days after the public hearing.

The above Notice must be published on the Public Legal Notice Website, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 45-1-101, at least 35 days before the public hearing. In addition, it must be published in the newspaper for four consecutive weeks, the last of which must be no less than 5 and no greater than 20 days before the public hearing.
