Draft Plan-EA Notice of Availability



Project Information

The United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), with assistance from Utah County as the project sponsor, announces the availability of the Draft Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment (Plan-EA) for the Santaquin Debris Basin Rehabilitation Project within the Santaquin Watershed in Utah County, Utah. The project would improve flood prevention for the community downstream of the debris basin and bring the Santaquin dam up to current NRCS and Utah engineering standards.

An evaluation of potential project alternatives and associated environmental impacts has been documented in the form of a Draft Plan-EA. NRCS and Utah County will hold a public meeting to provide information about the proposed project and to collect comments on the Draft Plan-EA.

NRCS invites you to submit comments anytime during the open comment period starting October 1, 2019 and ending on October 31, 2019. **Comments must be received by October 31, 2019.**

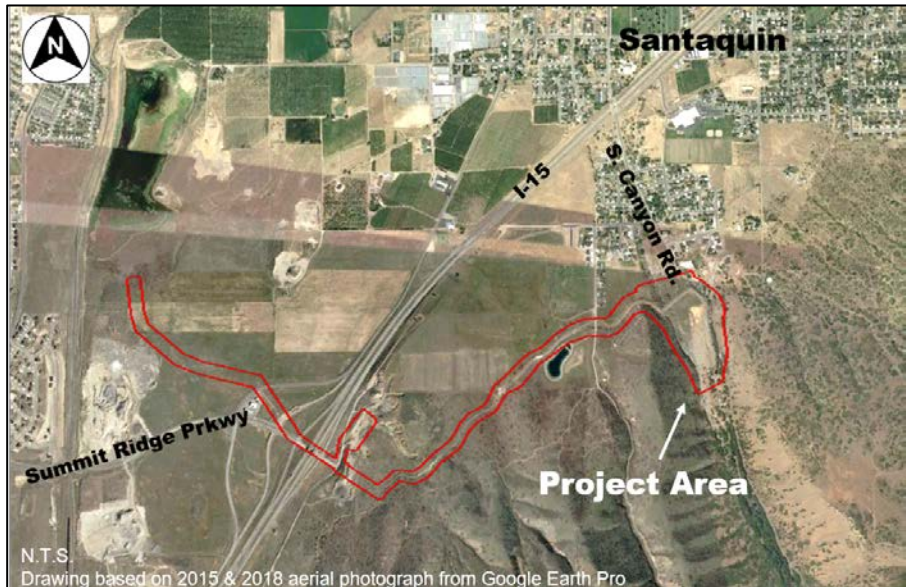
