Shirl Lorenzo Herget, 82, of South Jordan, UT, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family on March 2, 2024. He was born on December 26, 1941, in Lethbridge, Canada, the oldest of three children. Shirl was a dedicated worker, never complained, and had a deep love for his family, faith, and serving others.
