

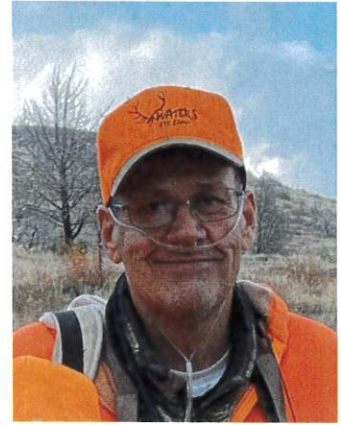
# Robert Bruce Waters - Walker Funeral Home
