

ORDINANCE NO. 10-04-2020

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LANGUAGE THAT PROHIBITS PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS FROM SERVING MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin is a fourth class city of the state of Utah; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has specific authority pursuant to Title 10, Chapter 9a Utah Code Ann. (1953 as amended) to adopt a zoning plan including an ordinance and map which divide the municipality into districts or zones and within such districts to regulate the erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair and uses of buildings and structures and the uses of land; and

WHEREAS, the state legislature has granted general welfare power to the City Council, independent, apart from, and in addition to, its specific grants of legislative authority, which enables the city to pass ordinances which are reasonably and appropriately related to the objectives of that power, i.e. providing for the public safety, health, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to allow Planning Commission members to serve more than two consecutive terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Santaquin City, State of Utah, as follows:

Section I. Amendments

Title 2 Chapter 1 Section 3 is created as follows: (underlined text is added, stricken text is deleted)

2-1-3: TERMS OF MEMBERS:

A. Length: The terms of the members shall be three (3) years commencing at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight on January ~~31~~ in the year in which they are appointed. The terms of the appointment shall be staggered at intervals, providing for not more than three (3) members having terms expire in the same year, to provide for uniformity in policy and personnel.

~~B. Consecutive Terms: No member of the commission shall serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms, except that a member may, at the request of the mayor, continue to serve until his successor has been appointed and approved.~~

~~B.~~ Shortened Terms Due To Vacancies: Vacancies for the term of any member whose term is not completed due to resignation, ineligibility, or dismissal, shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term in the manner otherwise provided in this chapter. (Ord. 01-02-2007, 1-24-2007, eff. 1-25-2007)

Section II. Severability

If any part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance or the application thereof to other persons and circumstances, but shall be confined to its operation to the section, subdivision, sentence or part of the section and the persons and circumstances directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council that this section would have been adopted if such invalid section, provisions, subdivision, sentence or part of a section or application had not been included.

Section III. Contrary Provisions Repealed

Any and all other provisions of the Santaquin City Code that are contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section IV. Codification, Inclusion in the Code, and Scrivener's Errors

It is the intent of the City Council that the provisions of this ordinance be made part of the Santaquin City Code as adopted, that sections of this ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered, and that the word ordinance may be changed to section, chapter, or other such appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intent regardless of whether such inclusion in a code is accomplished. Typographical errors which do not affect the intent of this ordinance may be authorized by the City without need of public hearing by its filing a corrected or re-codified copy of the same with the City Recorder.

Section V. Posting and Effective Date




