

# Santaquin City Resolution 03-12-2021

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PROVIDE OFFICIAL NOTICE TO PAYSON CITY OF THE TERMINATION OF ITS INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES DATED NOVEMBER 17, 2010**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Santaquin is a fourth class city in the State of Utah with the responsibility of providing for the collection and proper disposal of its solid waste for its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Santaquin City has an existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Payson City for Waste Disposal Services; and


~~**WHEREAS**, in Resolution 03-11-2021, Santaquin City has elected to enter into an agreement with Republic Services to change the disposal site of its solid waste to the Bayview Landfill, thus saving the city approximately \$28,000 annually for the duration of the agreement; and~~

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Payson City for Waste Disposal Services, Notice of Termination is required ninety (90) days before the anniversary date (July 1<sup>st</sup>) of the Agreement, thus necessitating a special meeting to approve said notice to meet this time requirement;


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City to authorize the Mayor to provide official notice to Payson City of the Termination of its Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Waste Disposal Services Dated November 17, 2010 with the attached letter.

Mr. Tucket,

Thank for your community's willingness to provide an exemption to the Notification of Termination provision of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Waste Disposal Services dated November 17, 2010, as outlined in your email dated March 30, 2021, 3:38 pm. This extra time will provide our community the opportunity to thoroughly review and consider the offer made by Payson City contained within that email.

Due to the language within the aforementioned agreement, and a need to overcome a technical requirement therein, our legal counsel recommended that the most appropriate course would be for our city council to approve the authorization to provide said notice with the understanding that said notification would be retracted if Santaquin City and Payson City were successful in completing the negotiations that would lead to an amendment and extension of the aforementioned interlocal agreement.

As such, please accept the enclosed notification to satisfy the terms of the agreement. However, please understand that it is Santaquin City's intent to use the additional time to review and consider the generous offer made by Payson City.
