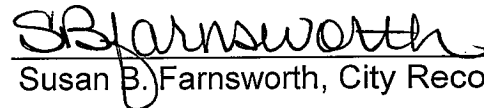
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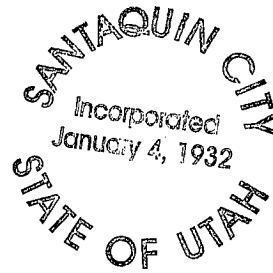
**SECTION 1:** The attached documents represent the Tentative Budget for Santaquin City Corporation for the Fiscal Year 2008/2009.
