

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDED PARKS & RECREATION MASTER PLAN, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Santaquin City (the "City") is a political subdivision of the State of Utah, authorized and organized under applicable provisions of Utah law; and

WHEREAS, Santaquin has experienced tremendous growth in the past and anticipates more growth in the future; and

WHEREAS, a parks and recreation master plan (Recreation Plan) is necessary for the management parks, open spaces, trails and other recreation facilities within the community, and Santaquin anticipates needing to expand its recreation systems and facilities as future growth occurs; and

WHEREAS, the City commissioned Blu Line Design and Horrocks Engineering to prepare a Recreation Plan to establish the long term plans for management of recreation infrastructure in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF Santaquin CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Adoption of Parks & Recreation Master Plan

The attached Recreation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Santaquin City Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

SECTION II. Codification, Inclusion in the Code, and Scrivener's Errors

It is the intent of the City Council that the provisions of this ordinance be made part of the City Code as adopted, that sections of this ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered, that the word ordinance may be changed to section, chapter, or other such appropriate phrase in order to accomplish such intent regardless of whether such inclusion in a code is accomplished, sections of the ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered. Typographical errors which do not affect the intent of this ordinance may be authorized by the City without need of public hearing by its filling a corrected or re-codified copy of the same with the City Recorder.

SECTION III. Severability

If any section, phrase, sentence, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION IV. Effective Date

The City Recorder shall deposit a copy of this ordinance in the official records of the City on January 5, 2017, and before 5:00 p.m. on that day, shall place a copy of this ordinance in three places within the City. This ordinance shall become effective at 5:00 p.m. on January 5, 2017.
