

ORDINANCE NO. 05-01-2018

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SANTAQUIN CITY CODE SECTION 8-4-9 PERTAINING TO THE HOURS OF AUTHORIZED USE OF SECONDARY WATER ON LAWNS, PROVIDING SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the State of Utah is the second most arid State in the Union with a limited water supply; and

WHEREAS, conservation of the State's water supply is a responsibility of the Utah Division of Water Resources (DWR) as well as all water system operators within the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is supports the efforts of DWR to conserve water; and

WHEREAS, to reduce the amount of water lost to evaporation, DWR is recommending a restriction on the use of water for the irrigation lawns during the hours of 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. to prevent watering during the heat of the day and by so doing increase the efficiency of the water used;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Santaquin City, State of Utah, as follows:

Section I. Amendments

Section 8-4-9 is enacted follows:

Section 8-4-9: HOURS OF AUTHORIZED USE OF SECONDARY WATER:

- A. It shall be unlawful to utilize water from Santaquin's Secondary Water System on lawns between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.

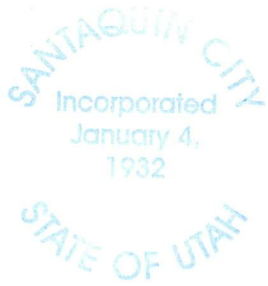
Section II. Severability

If any part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance or the application thereof to other persons and circumstances, but shall be confined to its operation to the section, subdivision, sentence or part of the section and the persons and circumstances directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council that this section would have been adopted if such invalid section, provisions, subdivision, sentence or part of a section or application had not been included.

Section III. Posting and Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 3, 2018. Prior to that time, the City Recorder shall deposit a copy of this ordinance in the official records of the City and place a copy of this ordinance in three places within the City.
